The prayer in the petition under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an appropriate writ thereby issuing directions to respondent nos.2 & 3 for protection of life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondent nos.4 to 6 with further prayer to not harass the petitioner by calling him to the police station on the basis of frivolous complaints.

The Counsel for the petitioner has been made aware of the reply dated 4.4.2022 as per which the representation of the petitioner has been filed with the observations that the petitioner has already filed divorce petition which is pending adjudication before the competent court.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the investigating agency to follow due

process of law in case the petitioner is sought to be called for the purposes of holding inquiry into any complaint registered at the instance of his wife.
