Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.60 dated 14.07.2021 under Sections 326, 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sarai Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran. The petitioner apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that though the alleged occurrence took place on 11.07.2021, but the FIR was lodged after a delay of three days i.e. on 14.07.2021. According to him, initially the FIR was registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC and the alleged injury suffered by the victim on his left little finger was later on declared as grievous, whereupon the offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was added. Learned counsel has further drawn the attention of the Court to the order dated 06.09.2021 and submitted that in compliance of the directions by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Narinder does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and according to him, the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.09.2021 is made absolute.
