The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.41 dated 17.06.2018 under Sections 304-A, 279 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Shahpurkandi, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that only presence of the petitioner in bailable offence is being sought to be secured by issuance of non-bailable warrants on account of failure of the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on the dates fixed which he contends that the petitioner was unable on account of his employment with GREF Depot at Siliguri, West Bengal. He contends that the absence of the petitioner was neither wilful nor voluntarily. However, considering that the

offences in question are bailable, the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court and furnish bail bonds to secure his bail. The present petition, thus, does not warrant any further action and is disposed of accordingly.
