Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.136 dated 18.10.2019, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar, under Section 376 IPC and Sections 4 & 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the said FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset has submitted that the petitioner has approached this Court for quashing of the FIR. He has submitted that the petitioner and the victim both are not only married but as on date they are parents of a child. He at the outset submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition at this stage with liberty to avail the remedies as available to the petitioner before the trial court. He further submits that as the petitioner and the victim both are residing happily with their child the trial court be directed to expedite the trial to save the parties from further agony.

The Court finds the prayer made is genuine and rational one.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with direction to the trial court to take into consideration the attending facts and circumstances of the case as on date and expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within six months
