RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the respondents to release the petitioner on interim bail for a period of two months in all of the cases pending against her on the ground that the petitioner is critically ill and is suffering from various medical ailments, including cancer and requires immediate medical attention.

The status report has been filed by the respondent-U.T., Chandigarh. It has been pointed out by the learned counsel for the respondent-U.T., Chandigarh, that the petitioner is facing as many as 11 FIRs in U.T., Chandigarh. Besides this, there are some more criminal cases pending against the petitioner in the State of Punjab and the State of

Himachal Pradesh; as well. Qua the medical problem of the petitioner, it has been stated in the status report filed by the U.T., Chandigarh that the due treatment, including the Chemotherapy and the requisite tests, including PET Scan, MRI Scan and CT Scan, are being regularly performed, as per the medical advice. There is no deficiency in treatments being provided to the petitioner.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to release the petitioner on interim bail.

Dismissed.
