1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 21.03.2022, in CWP-5585-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 21.03.2022, reveals that CWP-5585-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide claim made in legal notice dated 19.12.2019, within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any benefit, to extend the same within next four weeks.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced order dated 30.05.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as made in legal notice dated 19.12.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 30.05.2022, by way of

appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
