HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prayer of the petitioner in the present petition is to count the daily wage service rendered by the petitioner from October 1978 to 23.06.1987 as well as work charge service from 24.06.1987 to 21.07.1987 rendered by him as qualifying service for computing his pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though notice of motion has been issued but the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 09.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) filed by him, which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents raises no objection to the aforesaid prayer of the petitioner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice 09.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after deciding the said legal notice, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be released to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

As the main petition has been disposed of, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the civil miscellaneous application bearing No.CM-12534-CWP-2021 and the same is also disposed of accordingly.
