Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.104 dated 10.03.2022 registered under Section 11 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animal Act, 1960 and Section 13(2) of Haryana Gauvansh Sankrakshan and Gausvardhan Act, 2015 at Police Station Murthal, District Sonipat.

As per the allegations appearing on the record the police apprehended one truck/canter bearing registration No. UP-19-T-8921 loaded with 07 stray cows and 07 bulls driven by the co-accused Anwar, on 10.03.2022. The petitioner was nominated as accused he being the owner of the aforesaid truck/canter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police pursuant to the previous order of interim bail dated 21.09.2022.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Sandeep apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and is not required by the police for any further investigation and that the recoveries are

already effected in the present case.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 21.09.2022 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
