The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.76 dated 17.07.2020 registered under Sections 420, 34 IPC at Police Station Phull, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as also learned counsel for the complainant are in agreement that in pursuance to a compromise arrived at between their respective clients, the petitioner has already given to the complainant an amount of Rs.7 lakhs and for the balance amount of Rs.10 lakhs, has handed over to learned counsel for the complainant, in Court today, a demand draft favouring the complainant.

In the light of the above and because the petitioner is accused of a compoundable offence, subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of her arrest in FIR No.76 dated 17.07.2020 registered under Sections 420 and

34 IPC, 1908 at Police Station Phull, District Bathinda, he shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
