Ravinder-defendant has challenged the order dated 13.03.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Faridabad, in Civil Suit No.902/2018 filed by plaintiffs (respondents No.1 and 2), whereby their application for ad interim injunction for restraining the petitioner to interfere in the peaceful possession of their suit property was allowed. Further, the order dated 21.05.2022 (Annexure P-8) is assailed, whereby the police help has been provided to the plaintiffs.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the order dated 13.03.2019 passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Faridabad was appealable, but no such remedy was availed by the defendant. He is unable to justify the delay in challenging the said order after more than a period of three years. Consequently, the order providing police help passed on 21.05.2022 cannot be questioned, as it is in furtherance of the interim injunction order.

Resultantly, no ground is made out to exercise revisional jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
