SANT PARKASH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.250 dated 13.05.2019, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at P.S.Meham, District Rohtak.

On 10.01.2022, this Court passed the following orders:-

“Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

Reply dated 27.09.2021 by way of affidavit of Mahesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, along with Annexures R-1 and R-2 already filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though petitioner has no nexus whatsoever with the alleged offence, he is ready to join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency.

Learned State counsel also submits that petitioner may be directed to join investigation.

Adjourned to 22.02.2022.

Meanwhile, in the eventuality of arrest of petitioner in the instant case FIR, he shall be enlarged on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall join investigation on 14.01.2022 at 10:00 AM sharp before the Investigating Officer at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak and on any other subsequent date as informed to him by the Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall abide by conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.”

Upon instructions from SI Rajesh, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 10.01.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
