This order shall dispose of four writ petitions bearing CWP

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Nos.15215, 15224, 15248 and 15314 of 2022 as the issue involved herewith is identical.

The petitioners have challenged the order dated 18.05.2022 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.3-Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Hisar whereby directions have been issued to the Assistant Registrars not to release salaries to the employees more than the fixed salaries.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the pay scales of the petitioners, who are working with the respondent/Cooperative Societies on various posts, had been reduced. They had approached this Court by preferring several writ petitions including CWP No.11223 of 2016 which was disposed of by the order dated 09.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) with a direction to the committee which had been constituted to examine the issue with regard to pay scales of the employees of the Societies in terms of 'the Primary Agriculture Cooperative Societies Staff Service/Primary Cooperative Credit & Service Societies Rules, 2014', to consider the case of the petitioners and submit its report within a period of three months. Leaned counsel also submits that although the committee headed by respondent No.4-Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Fatehabad had been constituted by the order dated 14.01.2019 to suggest about the pay scales after considering the aforesaid rules, 2014 but the report has not been submitted despite the order of this Court.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

It is a matter of concern that despite the order of this Court, the

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committee is yet to submit its report. The committee headed by respondent No.4-Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Fatehabad is directed to submit its report within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Respondent No.2 shall consider the report of the committee and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners with regard to their grievance, pass a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months thereafter. Till the decision is taken by respondent No.2, no recovery shall be effected from the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
