After arguing for considerable period on the validity of the interim order dated 7th July 2022 (Annexure P-15), passed by Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench and when faced with the binding precedent of the Apex Court passed in *Union of India Vs. Alapan Bandyopadhyay*, 2022(1) SCT 348, counsel for the petitioners submit that he does not want to press the writ petition on account of the observations made therein.

Accordingly, he prays for withdrawal of the same, with liberty to avail his remedy before the court of competent jurisdiction, in view of the

law laid down by the Apex Court.

In view of the same, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
