The petitioner is aggrieved because allegedly he is not being permitted to construct an RCC wall adjoining his boundary wall to prevent seepage of water from the village pond.

Wherever a village pond exists close to inhabited areas, the local authorities have constructed boundary walls around them so as to prevent seepage into the residential houses. The boundary wall constructed in the town of the petitioner has allegedly collapsed and thus, the petitioner has offered to construct a portion thereof adjoining his residential house out of his own funds.

Writ in the nature of mandamus has been sought, however, the same cannot be issued as the petitioner has no right in law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press this writ petition. He may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to approach the concerned authority.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
