[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2 dated 22.12.2021 in CWP No.26436 of 2021 in case titled as Lakhbir Singh vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/2 reveals that CWP No.26436 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the official respondents to consider legal notice dated 11.08.2021 and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if the petitioner was found entitled and there was no impediment for release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay as per law.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to notice issued to respondent No.1, reply along with order, Annexure R-1/T dated 21.03.2022 has been filed by the learned

Additional Advocate General in court today and as per order, Annexure R-1/T dated 21.03.2022, claim of the petitioner has been rejected. Reply along with speaking order, Annexure R-1/T dated 21.03.2022 is taken on record. Copy thereof has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in view of speaking order, Annexure R-1/T dated 21.03.2022, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order, Annexure R-1/T dated 21.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
