Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction or order to meet the ends of justice especially with a prayer to direct respondents No.1 to 3 to enquire the matter on the representation dated 06.06.2019 of the petitioner (Annexure P-1).

On 23.01.2020, the following order was passed:

“As per the status report filed by the State in pursuance to order dated 12.06.2019 of this Court, during investigation, it has come to force that no such incident of gang-rape has been committed on the intervening night of 05-06.06.2019 with the petitioner and in fact, the instant FIR had been lodged in retaliation to a case, which had, in fact, been registered against the petitioner's husband and his companions for inflicting injuries on the person of the private respondents on 05.06.2019.

Petitioner remains un-represented.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 27.04.2020.”

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner even today.

In the circumstances, no further order in the matter is called upon.

The instant petition is disposed of.
