[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 13.08.2021 in CRM-M No.32766 of 2021 in case titled as Mohan vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel states that order dated 17.07.2022 has been passed in compliance of order, Annexure P/1 partly accepting the claim of the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 17.07.2022 passed by the respondent to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
