Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that some of the candidates, who had participated for appointment in pursuance to the advertisement No.12/2019 dated 20.07.2019, are not eligible in their category as the certificates of EWS submitted by them, is not in accordance with law.

Learned counsel submits that even though the said fact has been brought to the notice of the department concerned, but no action is being taken, which has necessitated in filing of the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the claim as being raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner with the respondents vide representation dated 10.06.2022 (Annexure P-8) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf

of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 10.06.2022 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner on 10.06.2022 (Annexure P-8), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 10.06.2022 (Annexure P-8) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It is made clear that while deciding the representation, the candidate against whom, the allegations have been made, be also heard and then only the representation be decided.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
