[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 18.03.2021, in CWP No.6354 of 2021 in case titled as '**Jora Singh versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.6354 of 2021, was disposed of by directing the official respondents to consider representation dated 15.09.2020 moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the notice issued to the respondents, respondent No.2 has passed order dated 24.11.2021, rejecting the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Kanungo. Order dated 24.11.2021 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who

on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 24.11.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
