The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 90 dated 23.04.2022, under Sections 379-B(2), 34 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Salem Tabri.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is in custody 24.04.2022 and investigation of the case has been completed and even the challan has been presented before the competent Court. He further submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and has got clean antecedents and even otherwise also as per the allegations the petitioner had allegedly snatched an amount of Rs. 1,93,500/- from the complainant. He submitted that in fact it was a concocted story in which the petitioner has been implicated and no further recovery is to be effected from the petitioner since the investigation of the

case has already been completed and therefore, the petitioner may be considered for the grant of regular bail.

On the other hand, Mr. Amit Rana, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has submitted that it is correct that the petitioner is in custody from 24.04.2022 and investigation of the case has been completed and no further recovery is to be effected from the petitioner. He submitted that however an amount of Rs. 55,000/- was recovered from the petitioner during the course of investigation. He submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The subject matter of the present case is Rs. 1,93,500/-. The petitioner is in custody from 24.04.2022 and investigation of the case has already been completed and as per the learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court deems it fit and proper to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be released on regular bail subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, anything observed hereinabove shall not be treated as an expression of opinion on merits of the case and is meant for the purpose of deciding the present petition only.
