Petitioner has filed this revision petition under Article 227 Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 12.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by Addl. District Judge, Rupnagar, whereby his application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC filed by him along with Civil Suit No.19 of 2022 titled as '*Gurmeet Singh Vs. Punjab Waqf Board and others*' seeking grant of ad interim injunction restraining the respondents from interfering in the peaceful possession of the property/agriculture land was declined.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that after filing of the suit on 12.05.2022, the defendants were served in July, who appeared on 07.07.2022 and on their request, the case is now fixed for filing written statement on 21.07.2022. Merely because the application for ad interim injunction is pending, would not be a ground to entertain this petition, as the same is yet to be adjudicated upon merits.
