The instant writ petition had been filed in 2016 to quash the action of the respondents whereby the petitioner has been kept under suspension beyond the period of more than seven months without any charge-sheet having been issued. The petitioner has relied upon instructions dated 02.07.1980 as issued by the Chief Secretary, Punjab to support his claim for re-instatement into service.

The suspension order dated 17.10.2015 (Annexure P-6) had been kept in abeyance till further orders vide order dated 03.06.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner stands retired and, therefore, the instant writ petition has rendered infructuous and he does not press the same.

Disposed of as infructuous.
