1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 24.02.2022 in CR-3142-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 24.02.2022 reveals that CR-3142-2021 was disposed of by directing the Gurudwara Commission to take a final decision on the petition pending before it within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.1-Gurudwara Commission has taken a final decision on the petition which was pending before it, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
