The petitioners herein have sought the relief of anticipatory/
pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.44
dated 13.05.2022 registered at Police Station Lambran, District Jalandhar
Rural, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC.

Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI
Baljinder Singh from the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that
in compliance of the order dated 20.07.2022 passed by this Court, the
petitioners have joined in the investigation and their custodial interrogation
is not required and moreover, they are also not involved in any other
criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned
State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail,
as extended to petitioner No.1 Jasvir Singh, petitioner No.2 Baljinder Singh
and petitioner No.3 Vishal, by this Court vide the said order dated

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20.07.2022, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
