Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner at this stage intends to approach the Government of Punjab, in order to convince them that claim of the petitioner for the grant of benefits, in respect of the military services rendered by him, is covered under Rule 4.4(b) of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, by filing an appropriate representation in this regard before the authorities concerned.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner before the authorities concerned, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions made by learned State counsel, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present

petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage with the liberty as prayed for.
