Prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to refix the pension of the petitioner, in terms of circular dated 15.12.2011 (Annexure P-1) and release the arrears thereof.

It is submitted that the petitioner who retired from the post of Superintendent on 30.04.2011, is entitled to the benefits as per the above said circular and as has been held in CWP-2866-2014 decided on 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-6) alongwith other connected petitions. It is further submitted that said order dated 30.09.2019 has since attained finality. In this respect, legal notice dated 19.04.2022 has also been submitted by the petitioner but to no avail.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts the prayer for a decision on legal notice dated 19.04.2022 (Annexure P-10), in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Advance copy of the writ petition stands served. Learned counsel for the State does not raise any serious objection to the restricted prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide legal notice dated 19.04.2022, Annexure P-10 filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, within three (03) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, petitioner is found entitled to any monetary benefit, same be released to him in accordance with law within the next two (02) months.
