The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 90 dated 06.06.2022 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, district Faridkot.

On 20.07.2022, this Court had passed the following order : -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case because the deceased committed suicide on account of certain disputes between the petitioner's cousin and the deceased; the petitioner has no other criminal antecedents; there is no evidence on record to connect the petitioner with the crime he is alleged to have committed; even if the case of the prosecution is taken as the gospel truth, though vehemently denied, the allegations against the petitioner that he used to take liquor with the deceased's husband and instigate him to beat the deceased are absolutely vague and unsubstantiated and in any case does not constitute abetment as defined under Section 107 IPC; co-accused — Sia @ Sia Kaur who has earlier

Sia @ Sia Kaur vs. State of Punjab has been granted
interim protection and that the petitioner is also ready and
willing to join and cooperate with the investigation.*

Notice of motion.

*Ms.Gunkirat Kaur, Assistant Advocate General,
Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.*

For arguments, adjourned to 19.10.2022.

To be heard along with CRM-M-28759-2022.

*In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining
investigation as and when called by the investigating
agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided
under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in
FIR No.90 dated 06.06.2022, registered under Sections
306 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District
Faridkot, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory
bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.*

*Before the adjourned date the State shall file a
status report after consideration of which further orders
shall be passed in the instant petition.”*

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted
order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the
investigation and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the
State.

After considering the submissions made on behalf of the
petitioner in the afore-quoted order and the statement made on behalf of the
State, the interim order of this Court dated 20.07.2022 granting ad interim
anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
