This is the petitioner's fourth attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR no.289, dated 21.11.2019, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station, Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended with 2400 Npx Tramadol Hydrochloride tablets of 100 mg each.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already suffered incarceration for a period of 2 years 9 months and 10 days and the trial of the case before the Special Court is not making any significant progress.

Per contra, the learned counsel representing the State of Haryana has submitted that the petitioner is also involved in FIR No.193 of 2018 registered under Section 22(c)/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

It has been stated by the learned counsel representing the

State of Haryana that out of total 14 witnesses that are to be examined, the statements of 5 prosecution witnesses have already been recorded.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the trial court is requested to make sincere endeavour for the early conclusion of the trial.
