The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for directing the respondents nos.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondent nos.5 & 6 who were trying and making an attempt to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No.PB02CR 9495 with the help of recovery agents and henchmen in violation of the judgments of Hon'ble Apex Court in *Citicorp Maruti Finance Ltd. Vs. S. Vijayalakshami 2012(1)SCC 1* and in *ICICI Bank Ltd. Vs. Parkash Kaur & Ors. (JT-2007(4) SC 39)* and by this Court in *Narinder Kumar Singla Vs. State of Punjab 2006(3) RCR 890* and *M/s Sundram Finance Ltd. Vs. Raj Kumar & Ors. 2011(4) RCR (Crl.) 890*.

The matter had come up for hearing on 14.06.2019 on which date the counsel for the petitioner had made a statement that he was ready and

willing to deposit the amount within 15 days from that day and in case the said amount was paid the re-possession of the vehicle would remain stayed.

Pursuant thereto the matter had come up for hearing on 30.08.2019 on which date none had appeared for the petitioner. Similar was the position on 11.12.2019 and on 17.01.2020. Even today none has put in appearance for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. The petitioner is free to avail his alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.
