Main case

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her minor daughter from the hands of private respondents No.5 to 14.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was married to Neetu Kumar on 16.03.2012 and a daughter was born out of the wedlock. However, during the subsistence of the first marriage, Neetu Kumar performed a second marriage. Due to harassment and ill-treatment being

meeted to the petitioner, she lodged FIR No.145 dated 16.10.2016 under Sections 498-A and 494 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur. Counsel submits that the husband of the petitioner unfortunately expired on 15.05.2021 and thereafter, the private respondents, who are his relatives, have been trying to evict her from the matrimonial home and have been intimidating her. He submits that during the pendency of the instant petition, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 17.08.2022, Annexure A-1, which is being not looked into. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to examine the same.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S.Grewal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

Considering the prayer made, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur-respondent No.3, to examine the representation, Annexure A-1, and to take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.
