Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.4 to 9.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner No.2 is the legally wedded wife of respondent No.4 and they are having stained relations and now petitioner No.2 is in live-in-relationship with petitioner No.1 and aforesaid private respondents are interfering into their life and are also extending threats to them and that in this regard, representation dated 15.7.2022 (Annexure P-3) has already been given but the police authorities failed to take any action.

Counsel for the petitioners further submitted that he will be satisfied if necessary action is taken by the authorities on the basis of the aforesaid representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana appearing for the

official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to consider representation dated 15.7.2022 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law in case there is any threat perception to the petitioners.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 9 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
