1. This petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 39, dated 30th April, 2022, under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

2. As per the case set up, marriage of Wadhwa Singh's son Bikar Singh (deceased) was solemnized 13-14 years back. The deceased being driver of Combine had gone to Madhya Pradesh for harvesting the crops. On return of the deceased, the petitioner along with her children left the house and went to her parental house, the deceased was under tension. On 29th April, 2022, he committed suicide by hanging himself with a tree. The allegations are that the deceased committed suicide due to harassment by the petitioner as she was having illicit relationship with another person.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no suicide note was left. Marriage of the petitioner with deceased solemnized 13-14 years ago and they have two children. The petitioner was not at home when the incident took place, she has been falsely implicated.

4. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail and submits that allegations are serious in nature.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering that there is no suicide note, marriage of the petitioner and the deceased was solemnized 13-14 years back, the petitioner has minor kids to look after, she has no criminal antecedents and co-accused were granted bail and conclusion of investigation and trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
6. The petition is allowed.
7. It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
