The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.66 dated 15.5.2021 registered under sections 376-D, 323 IPC at Police Station, Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 2.4.2022 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present FIR was lodged by respondent no.2 against the petitioners and on intervention of the respectable parties have compromised the matter and hence the prosecution of the petitioners is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Sakshi Bakshi, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Ms. Amarpreet Kaur, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Ramesh Kumar submits that after completion of investigation a cancellation report in the matter has been prepared and the same is likely to be filed before the court of competent jurisdiction within a period of one month.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating agency to submit the cancellation report before the court of competent jurisdiction within a period of one month from today, however, petitioners are at liberty to avail the alternate remedies available to them in accordance with law.
