Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that 37.5 marks were allocated by the respondents for academic achievements of a candidate concerned but the petitioners, inadvertently, could not upload their achievements so as to claim the benefit of the same, due to which, petitioners could not make the grade so as to be selected against the advertised post of Assistant Professor (Psychology). Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though, the result has already been declared but only the grievance of the petitioners is that they had raised the grievance before the Selecting Authority that the achievements that they assessed as per their achievements, which have been brought to the notice of the Selecting Authority by way of representation

dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-12), is still pending consideration and the same has not been decided hence, respondents may kindly be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Akashdeep Singh, Advocate for Mr. Kanwal Goyal, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondent-HPSC and accepts notice. He raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-12) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the representation, respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-12), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It is made clear that this Court is not making any observation with regard to the entitlement of the petitioners as raised in the present petition.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
