Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of technical pay scale of Rs.1200-2040 notionally w.e.f. 01.05.1990, which benefit has not been given to the petitioner. Further prayer of the petitioner is that upon the grant of the said benefit, the pension of the petitioner be also revised and the petitioner be given consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has raised the said grievance before the respondents as far back as in the year 2012 and though, vide letter dated 21.09.2012, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-11 with this petition, the case of the petitioner was forwarded for the grant of the benefit but the same has not been taken to a logical end so far despite expiry of more than nine months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, the respondents finally decide the claim of

the petitioner as proposed in the order Annexure P-11.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the decision has not been already taken with regard to the grant of technical pay scale of Rs.1200-2040 to the petitioner, the same will be taken by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present writ petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
