The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 155 dated 23.06.2018 registered
under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Julana, district
Jind.

On 17.06.2019, this Court had passed the following order : -

*“ Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that in the present case cancellation report was prepared
by SHO, P.S. Julana and in this regard, information was
sent to District Development and Panchayat Officer on
30.9.2018 and in the letter dated 6.1.2017 (Annexure P-3)
issued by Deputy Commissioner, there is a reference of a
report tendered by Secretary, Haryana School Education
Board showing that the petitioner had appeared and
passed the matriculation examination. Thus, no case is
made out against the petitioner. Learned counsel has*

further submitted that due to the political pressure, the present case has been registered against the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 22.7.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 sub Section 2 Clause (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 17.06.2019, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
