This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.49 dated 02.04.2018 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 452 and 149 of IPC have been added later on) at Police Station Urban Estate Patiala, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, apart from respondent No.2, there is one more victim i.e., Sahil Sood with whom no compromise has been effected and the said person is also not made party in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after impleading all the necessary parties in the petition.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforesaid.
