[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 27.05.2022, in CRWP No.4864 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that while adjourning the matter on 27.05.2022 for 14.07.2022, the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana, as well as Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, were directed to ensure that within one month, ground floor of the house in question was got vacated from respondent Nos.4 & 5 in CRWP No.4864 of 2022 i.e. respondent Nos.3 & 4 in the instant petition and a separate boundary wall constructed giving independent passage to the ground floor as also to ensure protection to life and liberty of the petitioner.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful having been done in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 27.05.2022, in CRWP No.4864 of 2022, he does not wish to pursue the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
