The petitioner is seeking issuance of necessary directions to respondents nos. 1 and 2 to protect her life and liberty as she apprehends danger at the instance of respondents No. 4 to 8 and also for the proper investigation of case bearing FIR No. 237 dated 16.11.2021 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sahnewal District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel submits that the present case is an outcome of matrimonial dispute. Respondent Nos.7 and 8 have been found to be innocent. The investigation qua respondents No. 4, 5 and 6 is pending. They have been granted bail and the challan shall be presented against them in a short period of time. Furthermore, there is no threat perception and apprehension of danger to life and liberty of the petitioner at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 8 is without any substance. Even the petitioner has

not submitted any complaint apprehending any such threat or apprehension to the Police authorities.

Keeping in view the fact that none has joined the proceedings on behalf of the petitioner and in view of the statement of the learned State counsel, no further action is called for and the petition stands disposed of.
