Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, claim of the petitioner is that he is entitled for the grant of salary equivalent to his junior, namely Ram Pal @ Ram Phal, on the ground that the said junior employee was extended the benefit of promotion under the reserve category, in preference to the petitioner, but the petitioner had caught the said Ram Pal @ Ram Phal in the Promotion Cadre, so as to become entitled for the grant of benefit of step up in his pay, equivalent to the said junior employee.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the fact that the petitioner has raised the said grievance more than once before the respondents by way of filing a number of representations and reminders, they are still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, and therefore, the petitioner has to approach this Court for redressal of his grievances.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the

petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.1 to decide the representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-14), by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioner to decide the representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-14) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in the representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-14), this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-14), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
