Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for quashing the impugned order dated 07.07.2022 (P-3) qua the petitioner, whereby, he was transferred from District Tarn Taran to Gandiwind, Amritsar with additional charge of Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his clients would be satisfied in case, representation dated 08.07.2022 (P-7) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

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In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Finance Commissioner, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Mohali, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 08.07.2022 (P-7), by passing a reasoned order within a week from today.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
