The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.282 dated 03.12.2021 under Sections 323, 341, 324, 506, 447, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC and Sections 326 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karamvir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated July 20, 2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated July 20, 2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
