The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing GDR No.04 dated 27.02.2022 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 158 & 149 at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur (Annexure P-2) in FIR No.24 dated 27.02.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149, 336, 506 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.07.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Bharpur Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police Sub Division Sunam, District Sangrur and on instructions submits that the

petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 20.07.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.07.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
