Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner as Lecturer Political Science from the post of S.S.Mistress w.e.f. 16.05.2012 when her juniors and similar situated employees were promoted after making corrections in the Seniority List dated 19.06.2019 along with all consequential benefits including arrears of pay etc.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 21.10.2021 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 21.10.2021 (P-5) by passing reasoned order as per law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
