[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 13.05.2021, in CWP No.3401 of 2021 in case titled as 'Arun Kumar versus State of Haryana and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that vide order dated 13.05.2021 while adjourning the case for 17.08.2021, the respondents were directed to allow the petitioner to continue on the post of Sweeper in terms of order dated 19.04.2021 till regular incumbents were appointed by the official respondents.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, has filed compliance report by way of affidavit of Shri Rajiv Rattan, Director Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula, along with Annexure R-2, accepting the jointing report of the petitioner as Sweeper on 21.11.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal

thereof states that in view of the petitioner having been allowed to join in

terms of order (Annexure P-1), the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
