The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.21 dated 10.1.2019 under Section 6 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station, Rajendra Park, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 29.1.2019.

Learned State counsel submits that out of total 18 prosecution witnesses 15 have already been examined by the learned Trial Court and the case is fixed for examination of the rest of the witnesses on 5.8.2022.

In view of the above position, this court is of the view that trial being at the fag end, this is not the appropriate state for entertaining this petition, however, keeping in view the custody of the petitioner, learned Trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same.
