SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.67 dated 07.08.2021, registered under Sections 306 and 506 IPC at Police Station GRP, Ludhiana.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was demanding return of his money which he had lent to the deceased.

At the time of resumed hearing today, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the parties have entered into a settlement and further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

The factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties has been duly acknowledged by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact with regard to the compromise and further upon instruction from ASI Sawan Singh, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation

and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Keeping in view the above, the order dated 25.08.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
