HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner was not granted the benefit of maternity leave despite the fact that she was entitled for the same.

After notice of motion, the respondents have appeared and the learned counsel for the respondents submits that though earlier there was some communication gap but on 30.08.2022, keeping in view the approval given by the Additional Chief Secretary (School Education)-cum-Vice Chairman of Executive Committee of Samgra Shiksha with regard to the grant of maternity leave keeping in view the concurrence granted by the Finance Department on 23.08.2022, directions have been issued to consider the employees, who are covered by the said decision and evaluate their claim and in case found meritorious, relief be extended to them.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner will also be considered under the order dated 30.08.2022

passed by Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana (School Education Department) and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 4 weeks from today and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to her within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents are yet to comply with the order dated 12.12.2017, by which cost was imposed and the same has not been implemented so far by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the said order will also be complied with within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above mentioned statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
