The petitioners- Taranpal Singh, Ranjit Singh and Punjab Singh have file the instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.518 dated 27.05.2017, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 342 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise between the parties.

As per the facts of the case, the complainant-Jagrup Kaur gave her statement to the police that she got married with petitioner NO.1-Taranpal Singh. She was harassed in the matrimonial home on account of demand of money. The entire family was raising demand for a big car. Her jewellery was also mortgaged. She was given merciless beatings. Her family had satisfied their demand at 3-4 occasions.

Thereafter, she started doing course of a Boutique at Kunjpura Road,

Karnal. She was again beaten up by leveling false allegations. Her

family was called, who were also insulted. Ultimately, the matter was reported to the police and the present FIR has been registered.

The petitioners filed this petition for the quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. The petitioners and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. The detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal dated 28.10.2022. The statement of complainant-Jagroop Kaur has been recorded, where she confirmed the compromise with the petitioners. She confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion from any side and she has no objection regarding quashing of FIR

The petitioners-Taranpal Singh, Ranjit Singh and Punjab Singh also confirmed this fact in their separate statement. The statement of SI Jai Narayan is also recorded who further confirmed that the accused are neither involved in any other case nor have been declared as proclaimed offenders.

Therefore, from the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, it is clear that the compromise has been effected between the parties without any pressure, coercion or undue influence, which is acceptable to both the parties. They have mutually settled all their disputes. Now they will be able to live peacefully and future litigation will also come to an end. Therefore, no purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

Therefore considering these facts the petition filed by the petitioner is accepted and FIR No.518 dated 27.05.2017, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 342 of IPC at Police Station Sadar

Karnal, District Karnal and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
