Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.201 dated 02.09.2020, under Sections 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 406 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab.

Vide order dated 24.09.2020 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 24.09.2020, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Vide order dated 24.03.2022, it was directed that the Investigating Officer present in the Court was not aware about the compliance of order dated 24.09.2020.

Learned State counsel has placed on record affidavit of Bikramjit Singh Brar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kharar-I, District SAS Nagar (Mohali). Perusal of the same would show that the petitioner has complied with the directions given in the order dated 24.09.2020.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that recovery of some of the gold articles and certificates remains to be effected.

After hearing counsel for the parties, it is evident that the case deserves to be decided on merits. Accordingly, interim order dated 24.09.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
